TRADITION BECOMES TIMELESS.

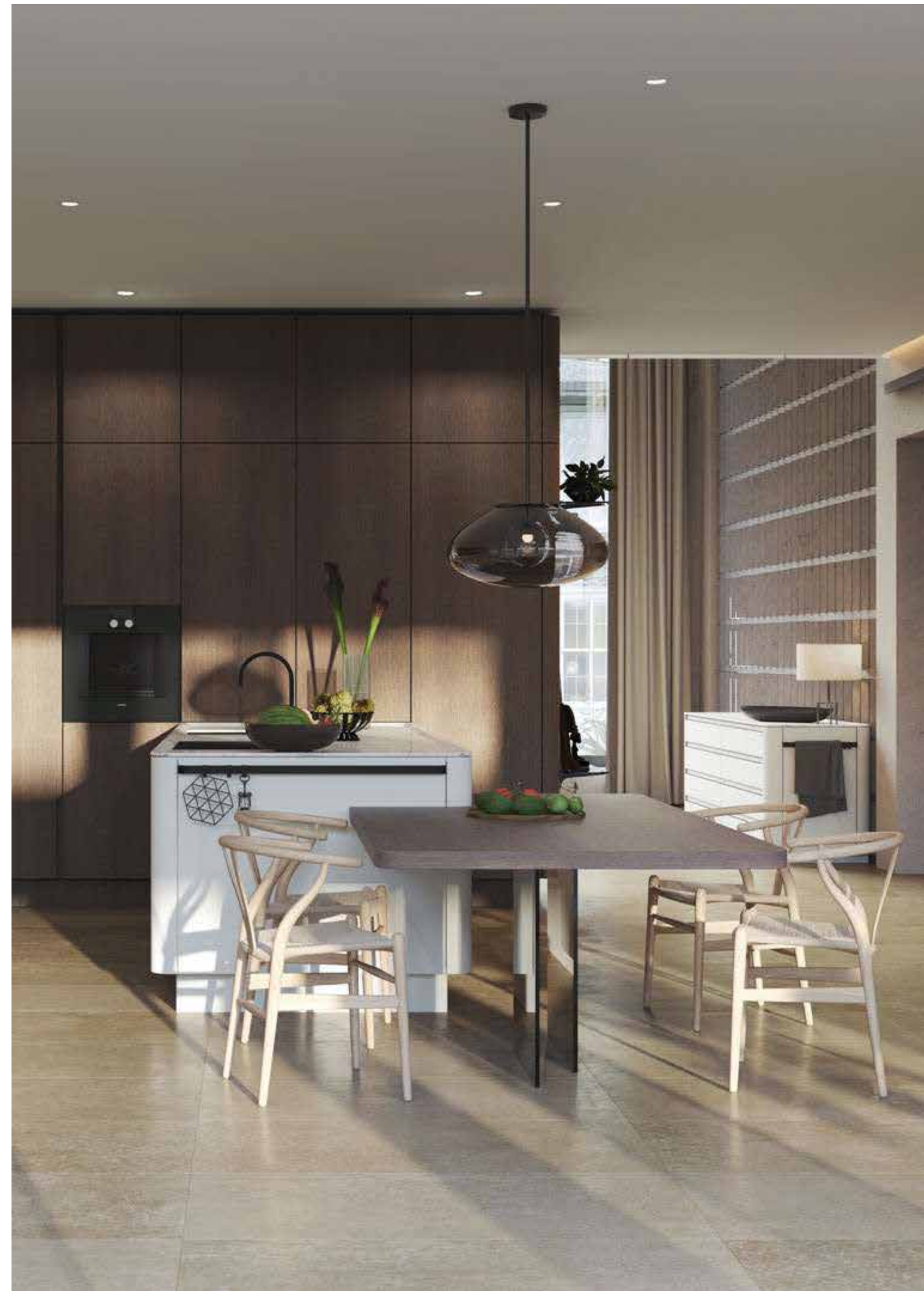
In the midst of pulsating city life, the spacious SieMatic SG6 with its warm wooden surfaces and organic curves provides a soothing haven of peace. Its subtle beauty of form radiates calm and security – a deliberate contrast to the hectic pace of urban life. The organic colour scheme with its natural materials creates a stylish living space with its very own character.



In the coexistence of historical substance and contemporary urbanity, Mexico City unfolds as a place full of contrasts. Here, Aztec temples meet Spanish churches, art nouveau villas meet functional 1950s buildings, and in between all this pulsates a creative scene that fuses centuries-old tradition with futuristic design in an inspiringly unconventional way.

Modern, authentic Mexican design speaks its very own aesthetic language. The contemporary, minimalist design of the open-plan kitchen composition is full of style and character. Nothing appears sterile, the shapes have weight, soul and presence. Made of contrasting dark wood, the dining table connects elegantly to the light-coloured kitchen peninsula.

With the open and closed areas of the urban-inspired living space, the asymmetrical, modular design extends far beyond the kitchen area. Skilfully positioned tall units act as room dividers, picking up on the elegant design of the invitingly open kitchen composition. At the back, luxurious glass cabinets skilfully showcase their inner workings and become the centrepiece of the living area.





FUNCTIONAL BEAUTY.

The stylishly staged materials, shapes and colours of the SG6 flow seamlessly into the living area. Warm colours and subtle black accents form points of focus. The slats detail of the display cabinets in the tall units echo the delicate lines of the SG6 strip handles on the kitchen island and, in combination with the vertical detailing of the elegant panelled wall, create subtle cohesion in the room.

Functionality and aesthetic coherence are also evident in the details: functional shelves and railing bars can be flexibly attached to the rounded side panels of the tall and base units, and shelves and lights can be attached to the panelled wall system. The organically rounded drip edge in the outer contour of the natural stone worktop is a visual and tactile experience that demonstrates perfect craftsmanship.

MEXICAN JOIE DE VIVRE FOR GOURMETS.

Camarones al Ajillo con Limón y Cilantro (garlic and chilli prawns with lime and coriander) conjures up the essence of the Mexican coast on your plate and is one of the most delicious dishes in Mexico with its refreshing, intense flavours.

CAMARONES AL AJILLO CON LIMÓN Y CILANTRO (SERVES 2)

INGREDIENTS:

- 300 g prawns, raw and peeled
- 2 tbsp olive oil
- 4 cloves of garlic, finely chopped
- 1-2 dried chilli peppers (e.g. guajillo or arbol), deseeded and in strips
- 1 tsp paprika powder (mild or smoked)
- 1 pinch of cumin
- Juice of 1 lime
- ½ tsp salt
- Freshly ground pepper
- 1 handful of fresh coriander, roughly chopped
- 100 g cooked yuca, potato cubes or corn kernels (optional)
- Lime wedges to serve
- Optional: a little tequila or mezcal to deglaze



PREPARATION:

Rinse the prawns and pat dry. Soak the chilli peppers in warm water for 10 minutes, then drain and cut into strips.

Heat the olive oil in a pan. Fry the garlic and soaked chilli strips over a medium heat until the garlic is golden brown. Add the prawns and season with paprika powder, cumin, salt and pepper. Fry for about 2-3 minutes per side until cooked and slightly caramelised.

Deglaze with lime juice (and optionally a dash of tequila), bring to the boil briefly. Add the cooked yuca, potatoes or sweetcorn, according to taste. Sprinkle with fresh coriander and serve with lime wedges. Ideal as a topping for tacos or with warm tortillas.

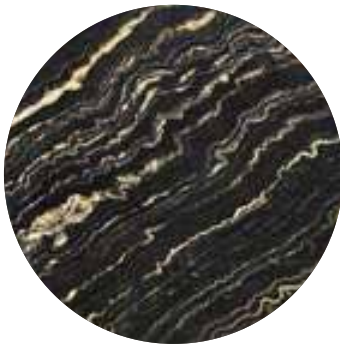
A GATEWAY BETWEEN HEAVEN AND EARTH.

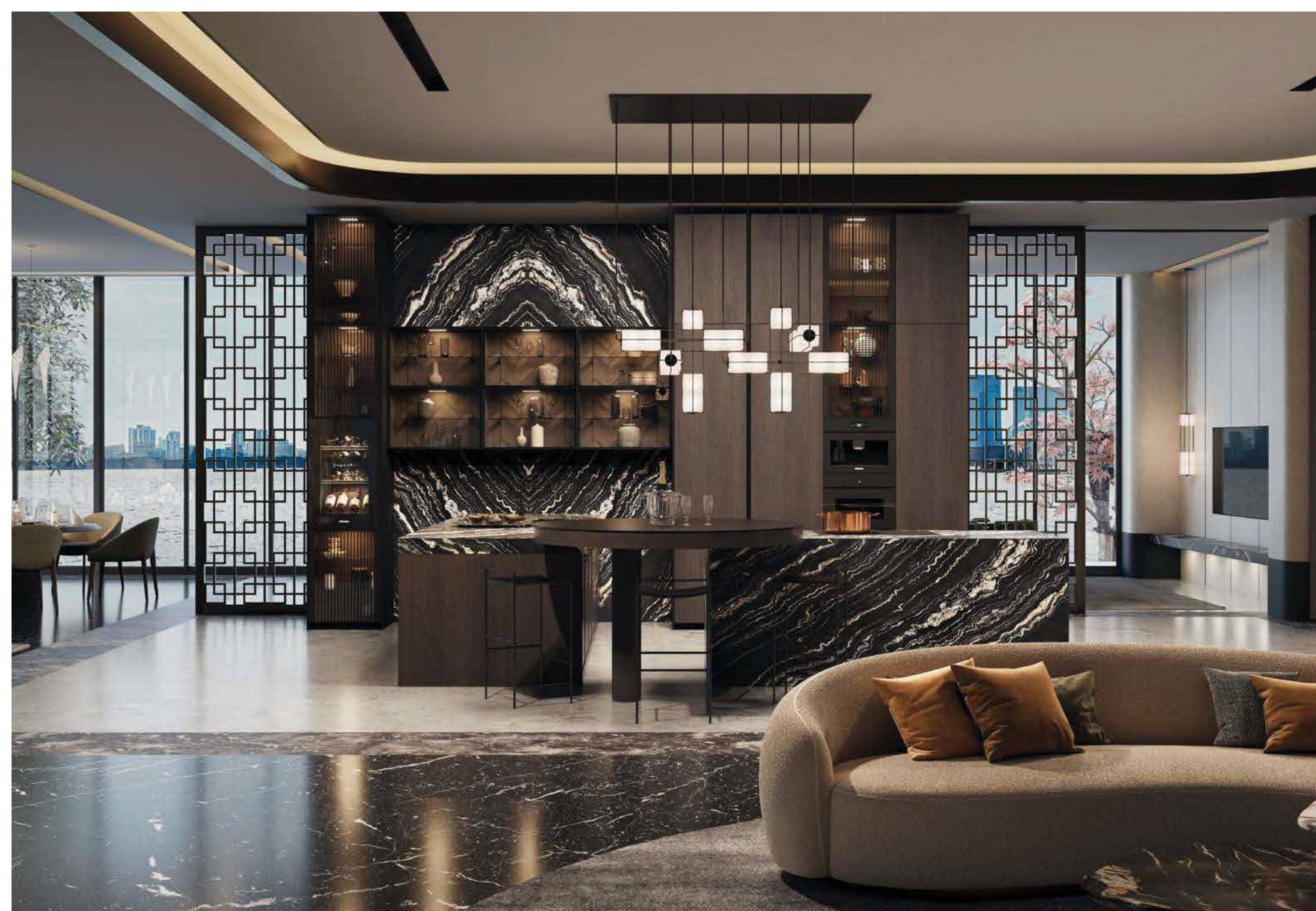


DISCOVERING ART IN THE EVERYDAY.

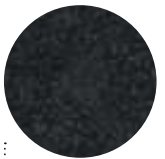

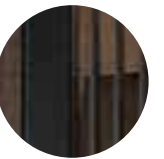

SUBTLE OPULENCE

Inspired by the quiet sophistication of Suzhou and composed for the stage of contemporary haute cuisine, this starter combines everything that makes great cooking: hand-picked freshness, perfect reduction and an interplay of depth, clarity and elegance. The red sesame vinaigrette – light, spicy, warm – envelops the flavour of the sea in a gesture of restraint. Nothing is too much. Everything is just right.

OYSTERS WITH RED SESAME VINAIGRETTE
(4 STARTER PORTIONS)

FOR THE OYSTERS:

Open 12 fresh oysters and place in the cleaned lower half shells
Crushed ice to serve

FOR THE RED SESAME VINAIGRETTE:

6 tbsp clear, unsalted tomato juice
3 tsp black rice vinegar
1 1/2 tsp light-coloured soy sauce
1 1/2 tsp roasted sesame oil
1 1/2 tsp fermented red chilli paste
3 tsp sugar or honey
A few dashes of lime juice or yuzu

Optional:
3 tsp finely grated red pepper or red daikon cress for depth of colour



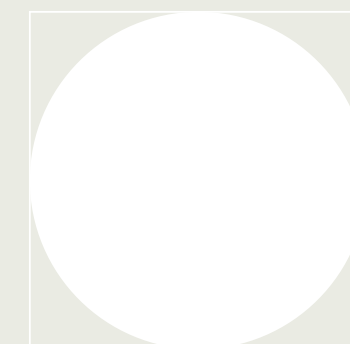
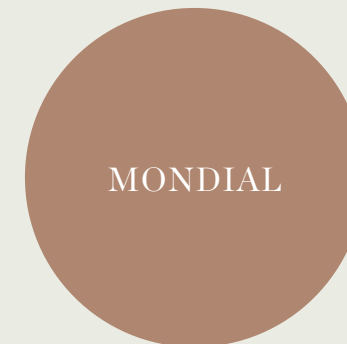
PREPARATION:

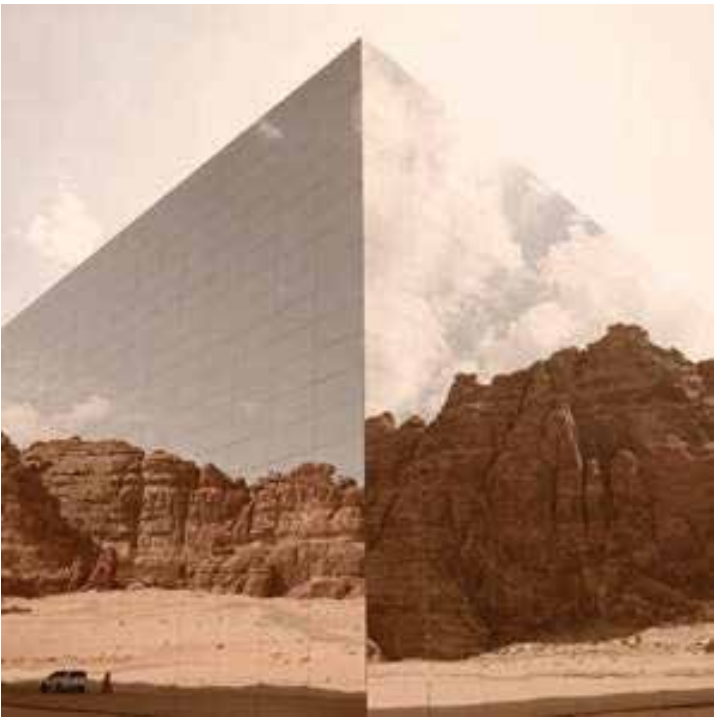
Mix all the vinaigrette ingredients together cold and blend finely. The consistency should be liquid and slightly oily.

If you don't want to serve the oysters raw, take a pan with a lid and steam them briefly in a tablespoon of rice wine until they are slightly firm but still tender.

Place 3 oysters in their lower half shells on a bed of crushed ice. Pour 1 teaspoon of the red vinaigrette over each oyster and drizzle with 1-2 drops of toasted sesame oil. To emphasise the beautiful play of colours, it is best served on a dark plate.

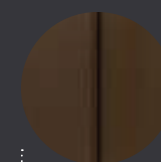
THE ART OF REDUCTION.

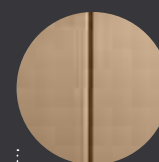

A JOURNEY INTO THE FLAVOURS OF THE ORIENT

Mashawi seduces the palate and heart with tender meat, oriental spices and intense roasted flavours. Between cumin, garlic and lemon juice, a delicious flavour experience unfolds that reflects a centuries-old authentic food culture.

ARABIAN MASHAWI KEBABS (4 PERSONS)

FOR THE MEAT:

800 g lamb
(e.g. leg or shoulder, boneless,
cut into even cubes)
Wooden or metal skewers

FOR THE MARINADE:

4 tbsp olive oil
1 tbsp yoghurt
3 cloves of garlic, crushed
1 tsp cumin
1 tsp coriander
1 tsp paprika
½ tsp cinnamon
½ tsp cardamom
1 tsp sumac
Juice of 1 lemon
Salt and black pepper



PREPARATION:

Mix all the ingredients for the marinade in a bowl, then add the meat and mix well. Cover and marinate for at least 4 hours, preferably overnight, in the fridge.

Thread the meat onto the skewers. Grill on the barbecue or in a grill pan over a medium to high heat for approx. 8-10 minutes, turning regularly, until the meat is nicely browned and cooked through.

Serve with pita bread, hummus or baba ghanoush, grilled vegetables (peppers, onions, tomatoes), yoghurt-mint sauce or a few squeezes of freshly squeezed lemon juice.

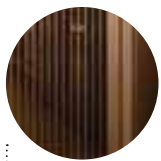
With breathtaking views that extend across the entire city, this property epitomises sophistication and modern design.

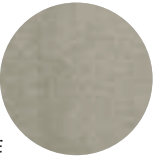

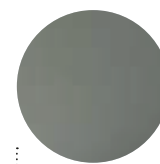


YORKSHIRE, ENGLAND: A RETREAT FOR MULTIPLE GENERATIONS.

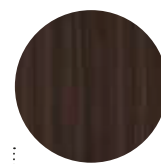

VIENNA, AUSTRIA: RAISE THE CURTAIN FOR URBAN LIVING!

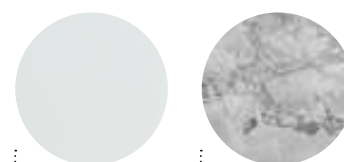

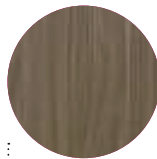


BIARRITZ, FRANCE: THE VITAL CONNECTION BETWEEN HEAD AND HEART.

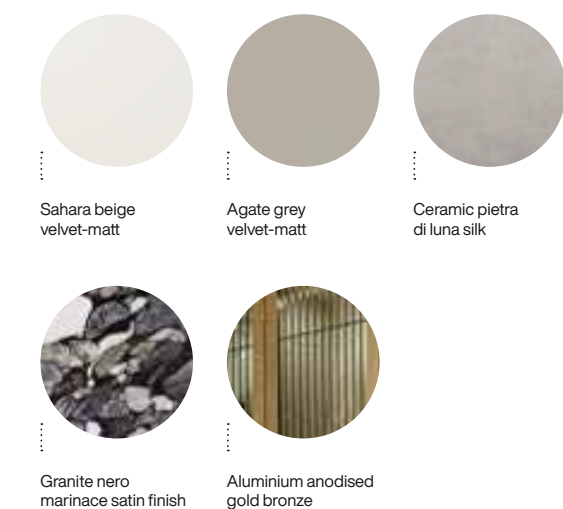


MUNICH, GERMANY: THE ELEGANT SIDE OF EXTRAVAGANCE.
